Acceptance of the Agenda: A motion was made by Robert Avery and seconded by David Standinger to accept the agenda for tonight's meeting. The motion carried.

Acceptance of the Previous Minutes: A motion was made by Roy Garfinkel and seconded by Matthew Palmer to accept the November and December 2017 meeting minutes. Under discussion it was noted that the item regarding the \$480 donation to SUNY Alfred was in error since the monies were actually to cover this year's fee for the CORS Network. The minutes were approved with the noted correction.
